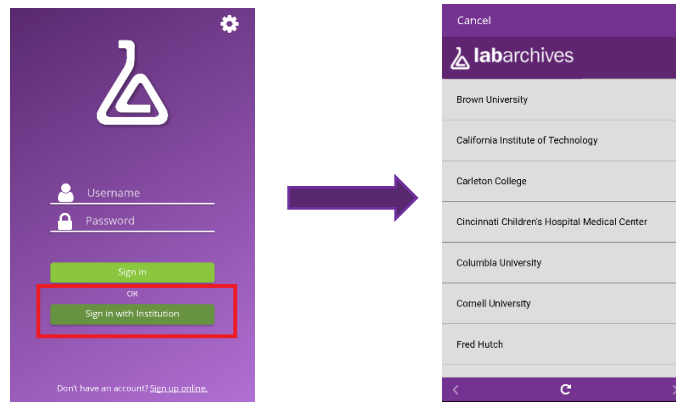


Access your LabArchives Account at UTHealth Houston on a Mobile Device

LabArchives Mobile App for iOS

Although we currently still provide access to the iOS mobile app, please note that we will be discontinuing the app soon and recommend that you instead access LabArchives via a browser using our new mobile friendly interface. Steps for browser access are in the next section of this document. Please keep in mind that there is not a separate mobile app for Inventory and you should access Inventory from a browser.

1. Download and Install the LabArchives Mobile app from the [App Store](#). Alternatively, you can launch LabArchives from a browser window on your mobile device. See the bottom section of this guide for steps on accessing from a mobile browser.
2. To login via the mobile app, tap “Sign in with Institution” and select “**UTHealth Houston**” from the list.



3. Login to the “**UTHealth Houston**” Single Sign-On to access your LabArchives Notebooks.

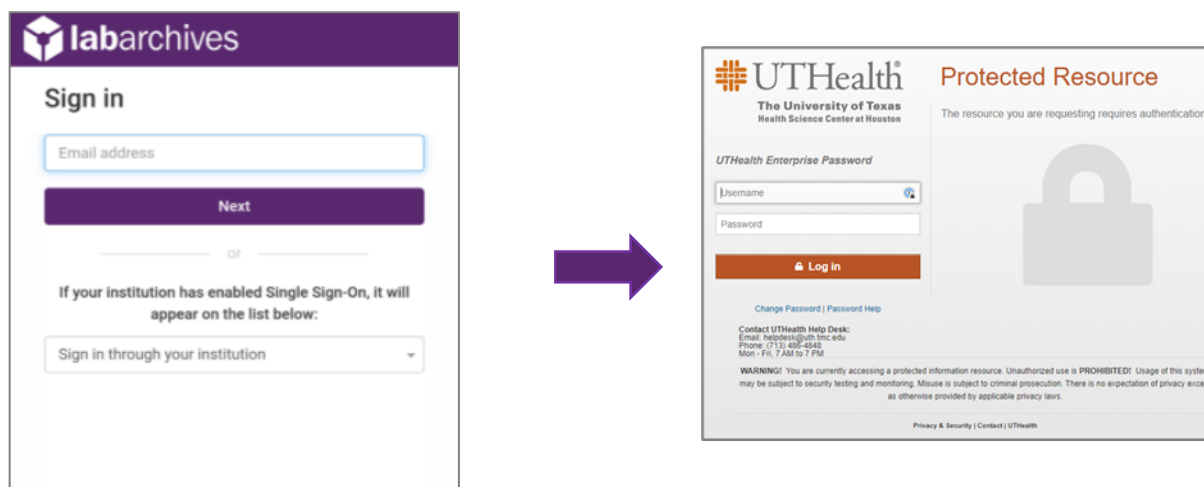

LabArchives for Android and Mobile Device Browser

The LabArchives Web App can be viewed easily right from the browser on any mobile device. If you want to access your notebooks on a tablet or smartphone you can simply use the web browser (Safari, Chrome, Firefox) on your device. It complements the full web version of LabArchives ELN and Inventory, while leveraging tablet and smartphone features such as image or video capture and voice to text.

Android users have an option to download the Progressive Web App from the [Google Play Store](#) which provides you with an app icon and a shortcut for launching LabArchives. This is not required to launch LabArchives on a browser, but it does provide an app-like experience. The iOS Progressive Web App is not yet available, but will be coming soon. iOS users should launch directly from a browser.

1. Launch the browser on your mobile device and enter the following web address:

2. Click "Sign in through your institution" and select **"UTHealth Houston"** from the list.



3. Login to the **"UTHealth Houston"** Single Sign-On to access your LabArchives Notebooks and Inventory.
